

# Kay's Jig

# Jig 4x32

- 01 – 04 1<sup>st</sup> lady with 2<sup>nd</sup> man and 3<sup>rd</sup> lady with 4<sup>th</sup> man dance half right hand turn and twirl to sidelines.
- 05 – 08 1<sup>st</sup> with 2<sup>nd</sup> couple and 3<sup>rd</sup> with 4<sup>th</sup> couple dance right hand across.
- 09 – 12 1<sup>st</sup> man with 2<sup>nd</sup> lady and 3<sup>rd</sup> man with 4<sup>th</sup> lady dance half left hand turn and twirl to sidelines.
- 13 – 16 2<sup>nd</sup> with 1<sup>st</sup> couple and 4<sup>th</sup> with 3<sup>rd</sup> couple dance left hands across.
- 17 – 20 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> couple (in 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place) dance a half figure of eight around the couple below them.
- 21 – 24 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couple dance a half figure of eight around the couple above them.
- 25 – 32 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> couple (bottom three couples) dance an allemande. (Order now: 2341)
